CONGRATULATIONS TO THE GRADUATES OF THE DEP IN SEAMANSHIP 2020-2021!

As of January 2018, the Centre de formation en mécanique de véhicules lourds (CFMVL) of the Centre de services scolaire des Navigateurs offers a diploma of professional studies (DEP) in Seamanship. This program is offered in partnership with the Centre de formation aux mesures d'urgence of the Institut maritime du Québec. (CFMU)

This is the first DEP created in the last twenty years. The seamanship program is intended to train crewmen who will be able to practise their trade both on deck and in the engine room. It was implemented in order to meet the labour needs of the Marine Industry and to develop Québec's expertise in this area.



This year, students completed the training on time, despite the days they were unable to access the school due to the pandemic. The students, teachers and principals of the training centres have shown a lot of agility and resilience to ensure the success of these cohorts!



The graduates have received all the necessary training to work on ships in Quebec and even internationally!

This program is highly coveted and there are only two cohorts per year. With 16 students per cohort, there are on average about thirty graduates per year. The year 2021-2022, which will begin in August 2021, will make it possible to reach the milestone of 100 graduates of the DEP in Seamanship.
