LAST CALL – CSMOIM MEMBERSHIP

Every year, the Sectorial Committee must update its list of members for the current operating year (April 1, 2018 – March 31, 2019).

MARINE CAREERS PROMOTIONAL CAMPAIGN – FIRM SELECTED

Another step has been completed in getting the digital marine careers promotional campaign under way. After the call for tenders stage, the three firms selected made presentations in mid-July to the members of the promotional campaign working group.

Following the presentations, the Québec City-based firm *Les mauvais garcons* was chosen to carry out this key project, which is supported financially by the Québec Maritime Strategy. The campaign, to be launched in fall 2018, will make extensive use of social media and the Internet to reach target clienteles.

MARINE INDUSTRY TRAINING NEEDS SURVEY

The summer holidays are unfortunately already drawing to a close and September is almost upon us! For the Sectorial Committee, fall means the marine industry training needs survey, and our team is already hard at work preparing this year's edition.

Knowing needs related to skills and training is central to the Committee's mandate. The annual survey allows us to draw up a list of Québec maritime organizations' needs and to meet them quickly and effectively.

Around mid-September, Sectorial Committee members will receive the 2018-2019 marine industry training needs survey form by email, which you are asked to complete and return to us (it can also be printed if you have difficulties).

We would remind you that your participation is essential. In addition to enabling us to adjust the training offered to our members' needs, the survey results are used in allocating Emploi Québec funding for regulatory training. Note that, again this year, only survey respondents will be eligible for this financial assistance.
