## 2018 MARINE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS WORKSHOP

Every year, the Sectorial Committee creates a unique occasion for marine industry stakeholders to get together to discuss regulatory issues and requirements for navigating personnel training and certification. This key event will run on February 21, 2018 at the Hôtel Plaza Québec (3031 boulevard Laurier, Québec, QC G1V 2M2).

Again this year, the Sectorial Committee and Transport Canada agreed that the main elements related to Marine Personnel Regulations raised in the workshop would be presented at the Regional Marine Advisory Council (RMAC) meeting to be held in March in Québec City. Under this agreement, Transport Canada representatives in Québec will ensure that workshop participants' questions and concerns are forwarded to Transport Canada marine regulatory authorities in Ottawa for appropriate follow-up.

The Marine Personnel Regulations workshop agenda will be sent to participants prior to the event.

## ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL EDITION OF GENERAL SHIPPING KNOWLEDGE TRAINING IN QUÉBEC CITY!

On November 30 in Québec City, our General Shipping Knowledge training session was given for the second time in 2017. The training took place at AFI Expertise on Rue du Marais and was attended by 13 people interested in learning more about the marine industry and its different stakeholders.

Given by Nicolas Parent, Senior Consultant with CPCS, the training session included two short presentations by Québec City maritime organizations. Mélissa Laliberté, St. Lawrence Economic Development Council (SODES), talked about her organization, its role and goals, going into more detail on SODES' overall activities. And, Anick Métivier, Port of Québec, spoke enthusiastically about his organization and its mission in addition to discussing the major project Beauport 2020, which is expected to generate significant development for the port and the Québec City marine industry.
