IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON EMPLOI-QUÉBEC FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR MARINE-SECTOR REGULATED TRAINING

To follow up on the training needs survey, funded spots were granted to maritime organizations until January 8, 2016 under Emploi-Québec's financial assistance program for marine-sector regulated training.

Unused funding is now available for marine-sector companies with eligible candidates.

Companies must contact the IMQ (Institut maritime du Québec) directly to register their participants for the courses. We will work with the IMQ, to process requests on a first come, first served basis in keeping with the Sectoral Committee's criteria of fairness and effectiveness.

Every year, the Sectoral Committee creates a unique opportunity to get maritime industry stakeholders together to discuss the issues and regulatory requirements affecting navigating personnel training and certification. This year's must-attend event will run on February 17 in Québec City.

As in the past, the Sectoral Committee has concluded an agreement with Transport Canada to have the main elements raised during the Marine Personnel Regulations workshop presented at the Regional Marine Advisory Council meeting to be held in Québec City in March.

Under the agreement, Transport Canada representatives in Québec will ensure that workshop participants' questions and concerns are forwarded to Transport Canada's marine regulations authorities in Ottawa to be addressed properly.
