GENERAL SHIPPING KNOWLEDGE TRAINING IN QUÉBEC CITY IN MAY!

For all shipping companies who will be hiring new staff this summer or who wish to offer introductory training to their current employees, a General Shipping Knowledge training session will be given in Québec City on May 10 at the Hôtel et Suites Normandin Québec (4700 Boulevard Pierre-Bertrand, Québec City, Québec, G2J 1A4). Once again, it will be given by expert trainer Nicolas Parent, Senior Consultant with CPCS. This is an excellent opportunity to train people who are from outside the marine sector but work in it now. The cost is \$250 plus taxes per person, meal included. Participants will receive course notes early in the day.

Various subjects will be addressed in the training session, including an introduction to shipping and the context surrounding it, key shipping stakeholders, marine-sector occupations, types of ships navigating the St. Lawrence and overall maritime transport system organization (legislation, framework).
