MARITIME WORKERS' HEALTH AND SAFETY: PROPOSED PARTNERSHIP WITH THE MARITIME STRATEGY

In the Quebec government Maritime Strategy's 2015-2020 action plan, the maritime workers' health and safety file is identified as an area in which the government intends to support the development of new types of maritime training.

In response to this objective, the Human Resources Sectorial Committee of the Maritime Industry (CSMOIM) approached the government to propose becoming partners in developing health and safety training tools targeting marine-sector lifting devices.

A proposal was submitted to the Secrétariat aux Affaires maritimes in July and we expect to hear back in early fall. Should our request be accepted, development of these tools will be supervised by a working group composed of maritime industry representatives who have already contributed to other training projects in the past. We will keep you informed of developments in this file.
