BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION

Reporting to the Assistant Director - Maintenance Planning and Coordination, the incumbent is responsible for the certification and regulatory monitoring of the Marine Works and Dredging business unit's fleet. He establishes the specifications and cost structure for major mechanical work. He must analyze the useful life cycles of equipment in order to support acquisition and maintenance projects. He participates in the establishment of repair budgets and follows up with the managers to ensure that they are respected.

RESPONSABILITIES

- Evaluate the work to be done on land and marine equipment (dredges, workboats, cranes, etc.);
- Establish and follow up on the budgets of major works, CAPEX (projects that can be capitalized);
- Follow up on expiring certifications and renew them (e.g. Division 3, IIS, ECRC, T/C, etc.);
- Ensure compliance of the fleet's maritime documents;
- Prepare specifications for major mechanical projects;
- Follow up on projects for equipment currently being maintained or repaired (dredges, workboats, cranes, etc.)
- Establish the useful life of equipment and plan for its renewal;
- Participate and support the activities of the Health, Safety and Environment Management System.

REQUIREMENTS

- Diploma in mechanical engineering or marine mechanics training;
- Experience in the marine field;
- Good knowledge of Office Suite software (Word and Excel);
- Good knowledge of Interal software (asset);
- Bilingualism in French and English, oral and written (asset).
