BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION

Reporting to the Department Head, Marine Expertise, the incumbent will be responsible for the management of nylon mooring lines and steel cables for Ocean Group. He will have to implement a maintenance and followup plan to maintain a high quality standard. In addition, he will support the Project Director by providing expertise for various Ocean Group projects. He will be responsible for administrative tasks and for providing the necessary materials to advance the various projects under his responsibility. He will ensure that the security of the site is maintained at all times. He will participate in the evaluation of needs, the development of content and the teaching of training related to his field of expertise.

RESPONSABILITIES

- Work in close collaboration with the Project Director in the realization of projects;
- Participate in needs assessment, content development and training related to his field of expertise;
- Support the Navigation team in the execution of special projects;
- Perform requisitions and research (as needed) to find new suppliers;
- Carry out the inventory of mooring lines and ensure follow-up;
- Manage monthly inspections of nylon mooring lines and steel cables;
- Implement and follow up on performance indicators on nylon and steel mooring lines;
- Implement an inspection and repair plan for nylon mooring lines;
- Implement a training plan for the inspection and repair of nylon mooring lines;
- Train staff on nylon mooring repairs;
- Order the necessary material from the procurement department;
- Receive goods, manage subcontracting and ensure that documentation and invoices are in order;
- In collaboration with the captain in charge of the tugboat, carry out the inventory of the towing equipment on board the tugs;
- Operate the crane truck of Ocean Towing, as needed;
- Participate and support the activities of the Health, Safety and Environment Management System.

REQUIREMENTS

- Professional degree and developed technical expertise in mooring management;
- Combination of three (3) to five (5) years of experience in the field of seamanship and mooring;
- Good knowledge of Office Suite software (Word and Excel);
- Very good knowledge of French and English, oral and written (asset);
- Ability to work in a team;
- Available to travel for work purposes;
