



## DO YOU KNOW THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE CERTIFICATES OF PROFICIENCY AND THE CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY?

### How to differentiate the certificates?

#### Certificate of Proficiency (CoP)

**Certificates issued from a training certificate**

\* Please note that certificates of proficiency are issued only for STCW training.

#### Certificate of Competency (CoC)

**Navigation and marine engineer certificates**

It is important to know that all STCW recognized training certificates are issued by an educational Institute (the Maritime Institute's Emergency Measures Training Center (CFMU) in Lévis or *another establishment recognized by TC*).

Following receipt of a training certificate, and when a CoP (certificate of proficiency) is required, **you must make an appointment with TC** in order to obtain the certificate of proficiency ("*passport*" format).

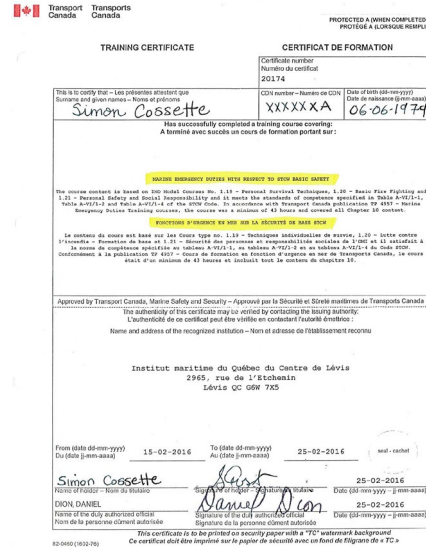
**For each and any other training session done after the reception of the COP ("*passport*" format)**

The candidate will receive a sticker to add to his qualifications register. All done remotely. Candidates should contact the CTC near their home and the procedures will be explained to them.

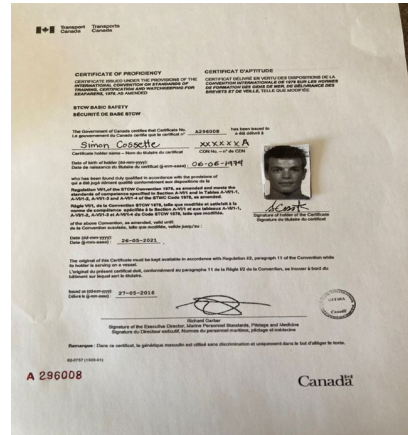
*Note that there are no longer any "*placemat*" formats issued. However, old "*placemat*" format documents are still valid until their expiration date.*

It is your responsibility to redo your training according to TC requirements at all times.

### Certificate of proficiency (CoP): the "*placemat*" format:



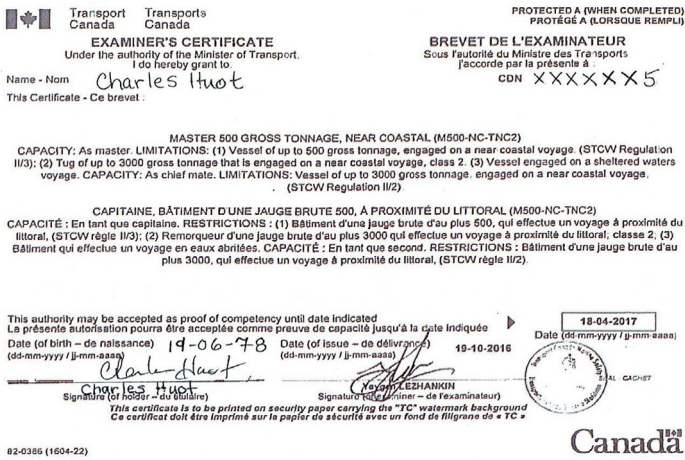
### Certificate of proficiency (CoP): the "*passport*" format:





Navigational and marine engineer certificates issued by Transport Canada:

Examiner's certificate: issued by the examiner following the successful completion of the last examination leading to the certificate.

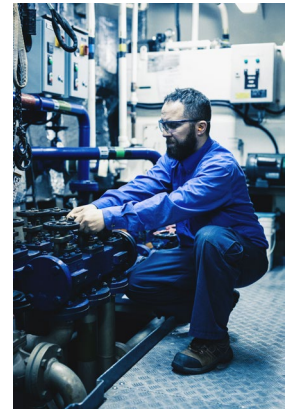
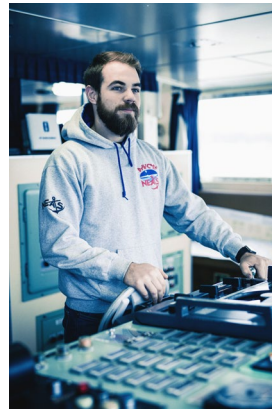
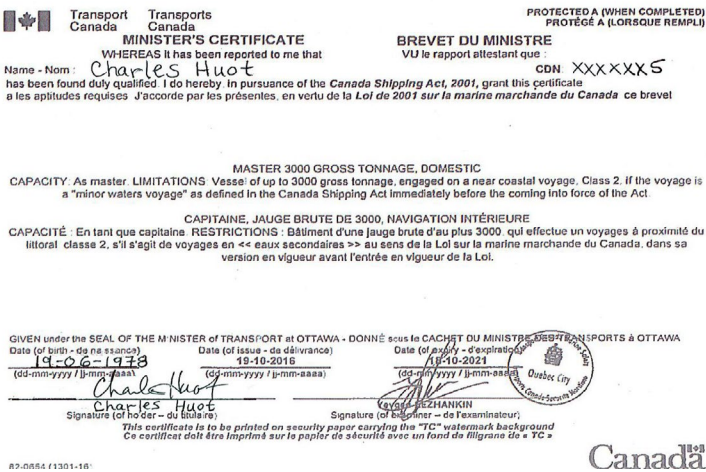


Certificate of Competency (CoC) - the "passport" format: Sent by mail following examination (for STCW navigational and marine engineers certificates only).
