# SECTORIAL COMMITTEE RECEIVES HISTORIC FUNDING OF \$3.5 M

On February 16, an announcement of great importance for the Human Resources Sectorial Committee of the Maritime Industry (CSMOIM) was made. While visiting the *Centre de formation aux mesures d'urgence* (CFMU) in Lévis, Minister of Employment and Minister Responsible for the Côte-Nord Region Kateri Champagne Jourdain announced a \$3.5-M agreement to be used to adapt refresher training totalling 22 hours for people in the maritime industry and related sectors. The Sectorial Committee mandated the *Collège de Rimouski* to do the work resulting, among others, from a regulatory review under way and from the need to innovate in the field of continuing education.

# 2023 MARINE PERSONNEL REGULATIONS (MPR) WORKSHOP

Our traditional Marine Personnel Regulations (MPR) workshop ran on February 22. We had the pleasure of welcoming 40 participants at *L'Hôtel Québec*: a strong comeback for our in-person training formula.

At the daylong workshop, Transport Canada representatives presented a number of updates regarding MRP effective dates (for both deck and engine room). The overhaul of the maritime medical program, which is under way, was also presented. Then, representatives from the *Collège de Rimouski, Centre de formation aux mesures d'urgence (CFMU)* and *Institut maritime du Québec (IMQ)* gave a presentation informing participants of the CFMU's 2021-2022 performance, the main adaptation and development projects under way in IMQ Continuing Education and an overview of current and future files regarding services offered to companies. 
