



## Tanker Vessel Chief Engineer

The **Chief Engineer** supervises all the mechanical and electrical operations of a vessel and ultimately answers to the Master. The Chief's authority is superseded only by the Master, and his responsibilities include but not limited to:



### His specific responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- supervising of all the functions of the Engine Room personnel
- Ensuring the safe and efficient operation of all mechanical and electrical equipment on board the vessel, including propulsion, operations, sanitation, and the smaller systems
- Continuing maintenance and testing of all equipment with particular reference to the safety of the equipment
- Assisting with the repair of all mechanical and electrical equipment by the appropriate personnel
- Maintaining and controlling reports and files regarding repairs, budget, inventories, and payroll
- Enhancing the learning experience for junior engineering crew and cadets



### Requirements:

- At least 6 months of experience in rank
- Certificate of competency as First-class engineer, Motor ship
- Certificate of proficiency in Advanced training for oil tanker cargo operations
- Certificate of proficiency in Advanced training for chemical tanker cargo operations (an asset)
- Advanced Training in liquified natural gas FOR FUEL (an asset)
- Certificate of proficiency - Marine medical care (an asset)
- Certificate of proficiency in Marine Emergency Duties
- STCW Marine Medical Certificate

All candidates must have relevant prior experience on board oil/chemical tankers and hold all appropriate STCW certificates, as indicated above. Holding Transport Canada certificates and endorsements is not required: Successful candidates will be supported by the Company in obtaining recognition of their STCW certificates and endorsements by Transport Canada, and employment will be conditional upon obtaining such recognition.
